SPD Pro Version 6.506 Now Released

Insequence is pleased to announce that SPD Pro™ version 6.506 is in final testing with general availability scheduled for January 31. This latest version of our flagship product includes customer requested Terminal Services/Thin Client architecture support including mobile handheld devices. The lower costs and IT support associated with a Thin Client environment are well known. If you are considering Thin Client architecture for your manufacturing, shipping, or warehousing operations, you'll be pleased to know that you can leverage your Insequence investment in support of your migration.

Other release capabilities include:

- o New Rack Load Verification (RLV) program for auditing the rack loading process. The new RLV program allows you to audit kits and kit components to ensure that kit components have been packaged properly and that the completed kits have been loaded on the rack as required.
- o New Messenger program feature that performs an automatic restart after a predefined number of minutes. This eliminates the problems caused when the program is not restarted after being stopped and all exports can now be sent via email, either in the body of the message or as an attachment.
- o Added support for IP-based external device controllers.
- o Added functionality for the MES Part Reject process. The new functionality allows you to reject a part based on visual inspection at any workstation, not just the workstation where the reject was noted.
- o Added functionality for the Ford ILVS Host. This program can now process 866 files for multiple ship-to locations.
